An innovative Crime & Community Safety initiative has been helping to keep People and Neighbourhoods Safer.

'OWL' is a technology tool that has improved communication and relationships between watch schemes, Police, Fire Service and other agencies and is helping in dealing with crime and antisocial behaviour.

It involves people working with 'Community Safety Partners' and its crime-reporting facilities make it easy for members to share information.

7.5 million messages have been sent to over 95,000 households and business, which receive OWL alerts managed through 16,000 watch schemes in areas of Wales & England.

Minister for crime prevention and anti social behaviour reduction Baroness Browning said:

"Neighbourhood Watch is a great example of how communities can come together to help reduce crime and anti-social behaviour and make our streets safer."

But it's important we keep this movement alive by encouraging new and more diverse membership, as well as embracing new and different ways of communicating."
